I've been praying about what to write to you this month and while out watering some of my thirsty plants I realized I was experiencing some of the curse God put on Adam! God had given Adam a strong warning and given consequences if he didn't follow His instructions about a particular tree in the garden. Adam was given free reign in the garden with only one(just 1) restriction. Wouldn't it be nice to only have one rule to follow?!

As we read in Genesis chapter 2 Adam was a gardener and caretaker of God's creation. Genesis 2:15-17. The LORD God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to work it and keep it.
