While thinking about what to write this month I drove by a local church and on their sign was the saying "COME IN FOR A FAITH LIFT!". I LOL and knew what my topic for this letter was to be about.

FAITH !!

Recently, I talked with someone concerned with serious family problems but, our conversation didn't go very well. I was trying to help this person to first deal with their attitude and problem solving methods as a way to bring healing to the family. This was not what they wanted to hear or do. In their opinion the problems all lay with the other people and they had no problems to deal with.

I'm currently reading the Old Testament Prophets and see a strong similarity with what was going on back then in Israel and what I'm seeing in my counseling. Back then people believed they were in the right and sought out people who reinforced their opinion. It didn't go well for Israel as they refused to trust God and obey Him and have faith in His word spoken by His prophets.

Today, with the belief that humans have evolved from some microscopic element it has caused humans to believe they are the only authority they can trust. The true and living God, and the Bible, have no value to them.

Hebrews 11 is often referred to as the faith chapter in the New Testament. I encourage you read the whole chapter-regularly but for the sake of space I'll only mention a couple of verses.

Hebrews 11:3 By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God

Hebrews 11:6 And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.
